## INFORMATION ON FELLOWSHIPS AND FINANCIAL AID 2012 - 2013

THE PURPOSE OF THIS DOCUMENT IS TO INFORM PROSPECTIVE STUDENTS OF THE GENERAL AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS.

*Please read this information and follow instructions carefully*

The Bologna Center allocates part of its annual budget to student financial aid. The amount available is generally distributed in the form of partial tuition grants to students who demonstrate outstanding academic merit and financial need. The Center also administers a number of awards (partial and full tuition fellowships) on behalf of donor institutions. All those who wish to be considered for either Bologna Center financial aid or any of the special fellowships administered by the Center must submit the following documents to the Bologna Center by:

**FEBRUARY 1, 2011** (deadline for applications for admission and financial aid at the Bologna Center).

- a complete "Application for Admission"
- a complete "Application for Financial Aid", signed by the candidate's parents
- proof of parents' income (tax declaration or other official proof)

Some donor institutions also require that candidates submit a fellowship application directly to them. See instructions overleaf.

Please note that:

- the requirements apply to all candidates, regardless of age or dependency status;
- all awards are competitive and are allocated on the basis of academic merit and demonstrated financial need;
- amounts of support vary, but most awards do not cover the full amount of tuition; therefore, even successful candidates are strongly encouraged to seek ALTERNATIVE SOURCES, as listed in the electronic version of this document available on our admission webpage. Most university libraries also carry "Grants Registers" which list sources of funding for education. Internet is also a good research tool for this purpose;
- those who do not adhere to the instructions for admission and the instructions to apply for financial aid as indicated in our application package may be excluded from consideration for admission and financial support;
- The Bologna Center does not grant tuition waivers.

### Instructions for applications

#### AUSTRIA

- **Austrian National Bank - TO BE CONFIRMED**

Award: One fellowship.

Eligibility: Austrian citizens.

Applications: To the Bologna Center by February 1.

- **City of Vienna**

Award: One fellowship

Eligibility: Austrian citizens, residents in Vienna.

Applications: To the Bologna Center by February 1. Applicants should clearly state their interest in this fellowship on their application form.

- **Josef Krainer-Steirisches Gedenkwerk**

Award: One fellowship

Eligibility: Austrian citizenship, born or resident in Styria or holding a degree from a university in Styria.

Applications: To the Bologna Center by February 1 AND to the Foundation, c/o Dr. Hubert Isak, Karl Franz Universität Graz, Forschungsinstitut für Europarecht, ReSoWi-Zentrum, Universitätsstrasse 15/C.1, A-8010 Graz (verify deadline directly with foundation)

#### GERMANY

- **Deutscher Akademischer Austauschdienst (DAAD)**

Award: Some partial fellowships and one full tuition and maintenance fellowship in memory of Gerold von Braunmühl.

Eligibility: German citizenship with a degree from a German University.

- **Fritz Thyssen Stiftung - TO BE CONFIRMED**

Award: Fellowships covering full or partial tuition

Eligibility: German citizenship

Applications: To the Bologna Center by February 1

- **Konrad-Adenauer-Stiftung**

Award: One/two fellowships jointly sponsored by Adenauer Stiftung and the Bologna Center.

Eligibility: Adenauer Scholars.

- Eligibility: Studienstiftung Scholars only. Eligible students must prove they are Studienstiftung Scholars when applying to the Bologna Center

## GREECE

- **Stavros Niarchos Foundation Fellowship**

- Award: Several fellowships for the 2 year SAIS MA program
- Eligibility: The fellowships are available for students from Greece or Eastern Europe
- Applications: To the Bologna Center by February 1

## ITALY

- **Carlo Maria Santoro Memorial Fellowship**

- Award: One fellowship
- Eligibility: Italian citizenship. Strong interest in International Relations and/or European Studies. Preference will be given to a candidate from Rome or a University in Rome
- Applications: To the Bologna Center by February 1.

- **Fondazione del Monte di Bologna e Ravenna Fellowship**

- Award: Two fellowships
- Eligibility: Italian citizenship. Preference will be given to a candidate from Bologna and/or Ravenna
- Applications: To the Bologna Center by February 1.

- **Enzo Grilli Memorial Fellowship by Banca d'Italia**

- Award: One fellowship
- Eligibility: Italian citizenship. Strong interest in Economics and International Relations.
- Applications: To the Bologna Center by February 1.

## ROMANIA, RUSSIA, SLOVAKIA

- **Enel Fellowship**

- Award: One fellowship
- Eligibility: The fellowship is available for only one student from Romania or Russia or Slovakia.
- Applications: To the Bologna Center by February 1.

## SPAIN

- **The Blue Foundation Fellowship**

- Award: One fellowship for the 2 year MA/MAIA program
- Eligibility: Spanish citizens
- Applications: To the Bologna Center by February 1

## UNITED KINGDOM

- **Student Awards Agency for Scotland (SAAS)**

Award: One fellowship

Applications: To the Bologna Center by February 1.

- **Welsh Assembly Government**

Award: Funding made available for one year of study at the Bologna Center.

Eligibility: A student who on the relevant date:

- a) is settled in the United Kingdom;
- b) is ordinarily resident in Wales; and
- c) had been ordinarily resident throughout the three-year period preceding the relevant date in the United Kingdom.

Applications: To the Bologna Center by February 1 (A successful student who is offered a place will be invited to apply for the Welsh Government financial support. The deadline for applications for financial support is June 30, 2012).

Award: One fellowship

Eligibility: British citizens

Applications: To the Bologna Center by February 1.

- **The Anderson Fellowship Fund**

Award: One fellowship

Eligibility: British citizens, preferably resident in Scotland
