to take advantage of the Inland Revenue Gift Aid Scheme**

**How Gift Aid works in the UK:**

The UK Inland Revenue Gift Aid Scheme allows UK tax payers to augment their gift to UK charities. Inland Revenue gives the charity back the basic rate tax the donor has paid on their gift. In addition, higher rate tax payers can reclaim the difference between the basic rate and the higher rate (22% and 40% respectively) on their annual tax reclaim.

- **One-off payment by cheque**

Please fill out and sign the Gift Aid Declaration form (below) and attach a cheque made out to “Bologna Center of the Johns Hopkins University UK Charitable Trust”.  
*Note* : the Gift Aid form does not need to be signed for each gift but only at the time of your first gift via the UK Charitable Trust.

- **Standing Order** for monthly, quarterly or annual payments over a specific amount of time.

Please request a form from the Trust Secretary.

- **GAYE (Give as you Earn)**

The Give-as-you-Earn scheme enables you to give tax-free straight from your pre-tax salary. If you wish to make a regular gift by GAYE to the Bologna Center UK Trust, please contact your Payroll Giving department who will ask you to complete a form. It would also be helpful if you could let the Trust Secretary know that you have done this, so she can look out for the payments when they arrive. In addition, some companies are prepared to 'match' the gifts by their employees under the GAYE scheme. Please check with your employer.
